The Oregon Department of Agriculture (Department) has reviewed and evaluated your application for a weather modification license in Umatilla County. After thorough consideration, the Department is issuing Rainmaker Technologies a license pursuant to ORS Chapter 558. This license is valid for one year from the date of this letter.

The license is issued strictly within the parameters outlined in your application and any associated addendums. Any future requests to renew this license must be submitted no later than 30 days before its expiration and will be subject to a full review. Should the scope of work or proposed modifications differ substantially from the original application, the Department may treat it as a new application, requiring compliance with all applicable programmatic requirements at that time.

This license does not preclude the need to obtain permits or approvals from other regulatory agencies, such as the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) or the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD). The Department strongly recommends consulting with these agencies to ensure compliance with all local, state, and federal requirements that may apply to your activities.

This license is issued under the authority of ORS Chapter 558, it does not constitute an assurance of compliance with any requirements outside the Department's jurisdiction.



Pursuant to ORS 558.110, you are required to maintain comprehensive records of all operations conducted under this license. These records must include the method employed and type of equipment used, the type and composition of materials used, the times and locations of equipment operation, the name and address of each person participating in the operation other than the licensee, the estimated precipitation gain or loss resulting from the operations (supported by relevant data), and any additional information required by the Department.
